2. If the applicant has written evidence as to the suitability of the place proposed for the handling of explosives then copies of that evidence should be enclosed. Reports of explosives surveys by the Ministry of Defence, Explosive Storage and Transport Committee, or existing explosives bylaws under the Explosives Act 1875, are examples of such evidence.
3. Charges are payable for work carried out in connection with the application. Signature of this application form is regarded as signifying acceptance of the statutory charges involved. The current fees are stated in paragraph 2.1 of the guidance.
